DESCRIPTION: Since grey is a hot colour for fall, this might be just the thing you need to update your wardrobe.

And this versatile piece of jewelry can be worn as a choker (43 cm) or opened up to become a necklace (81 cm). As a choker, the silver rings can be worn either at the front or the back depending on your mood, although the artist, herself, prefers to wear them at the front. Worn as a longer necklace, the rings become decorative rather than functional, and you can place them wherever you like.

The collection includes necklaces of other designs, bracelets and earrings which all come in other colours, too.

Designed and made by a Canadian who works with organic materials, this necklace is made of flat oval pieces of shell. It's also available at Holt Renfrew where it was featured in its Must-Have Event. But isn't it a whole lot easier to pick it up close at hand in Guelph?
